

Seminar: International Perspectives on Multilingual Childhoods

In diverse and heterogenous societies, migration and multilingualism play a crucial role in language acquisition and support in ECEC institutions. Countries, regions and institutions have different traditions regarding the use of several languages, ranging from the official use of more than one language in everyday life to monolingual traditions, in which families with different mother languages are perceived as problematic. This series of international lectures sheds light on how ECEC institutions deal with diverse languages, and what we can learn from each other when fostering language acquisition and support in multilingual contexts.
